'Bencastor Dignity' was originally


created in 1977, reprinted in 2002 at Whitewall Galery.

Warburg archive

- research is entirely subjective (like what gets prioritised)
- our curatorial decisions offer no true opportunity to explore subjects in relation to our brief and to changing research
- named after Aby Warburg, son of successful banker. owned about 5000 books at the time of his death - often about Italian renaissance



interested in:


how had classic sculpture absorbed and entered the renaissance?
